

## The Expert Preceptor Interactive Curriculum (EPIC) New Users' Login Instructions

1. The URL for EPIC is <http://www.med.unc.edu/epic/welcome.htm>. You may wish to save this address in your "favorites" folder for easy access later.
2. Click on [register](#) under "New Users" and create a login name and password.
3. Click on the [EPIC without continuing education credit](#) option. Note: Category I CME credit is no longer an available option for EPIC, although UTMB does count participation in EPIC toward qualification for preceptor recognition awards.
4. Fill out the [EPIC Registration](#) page. There is no fee associated with your registration. Check the final box, "[Expert Preceptor Designation](#)" so that you will have access to all of the available modules.
5. Upon completion of the registration page, you will then be asked to participate in a survey. You can complete the survey or continue on to the [EPIC login page](#) by clicking on [confirm registration](#).
6. Enter your newly created [Login Name](#) and [Password](#) and click on [submit](#). You now have the ability to begin any of the 10 modules provided and work at your own pace, i.e. you can logout in the middle of a module and continue from the point at which you stopped at a later time.
